

In-Charge™ Lockers - User Guide



STEP 1

Select required compartment and open locker door.



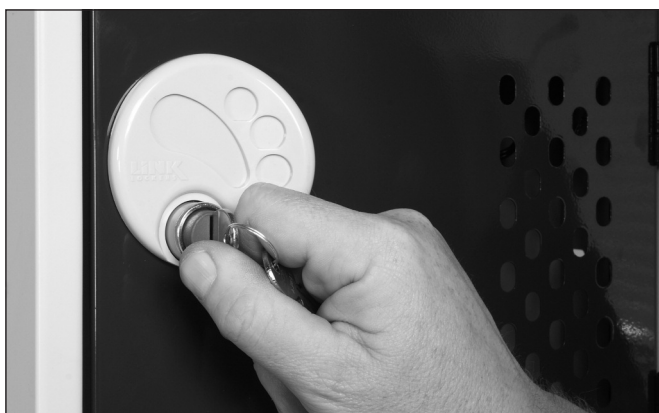
STEP 2

Plug in charger..



STEP 3

Plug in item for charging.



STEP 4

Close locker door and lock. Remove key and note locker position or compartment number.

Typical example of items suitable for charging

- Mobile Phone
- Laptop
- Digital camera
- Battery operated Power tool

The In-Charge™ locker must be used in accordance with the following:-

Charging items

- The In-Charge™ locker must only be used to charge low voltage items
- Only to be used with PAT tested components
- Only to be used with items inside the locker compartments
- No trailing wires to be outside the locker
- Only use manufacture approved replacement parts

Areas for use

- Indoor use only
- Dry areas only
- For use in ambient temperature applications only (16-22 degrees centigrade)
- not to be used in kitchens, changing rooms etc.
- Clean areas only, no appreciable build up of dust is acceptable.

Operation and maintenance

- There are no user maintainable components in the locker
- Any maintenance must be carried out by the supplier
- Ventilation must be maintained, do not cover or block any ventilation holes.
- No flammable items to be stored in the lockers

If a fault occurs

- Check the RCD and re set if required**
- If this does not resolve the problem contact the supplier**
