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POLICY PRINCIPLES

The following principles display how Coldcurve expect the policy statement to be achieved, and should be used to guide behaviours, decision making and action:

Environment Protection

- In order to protect the environment and operate in sustainable way. 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Resource Efficiency

 - Selecting materials that have sustainable lifecycle impacts.
