Resin Bound Tree Pit

Resin bound paving with 6 - 10mm aggregate laid to a depth from 40 - 100mm dependent on location.

Includes a tree collar to allow tree to grow and if required, a water irrigation system.

Resin Bound Tree Pit

A collar is not necessary with well established trees.

Sub-Base

MOT Type 1 sub-base laid by others in accordance with urban planting specification at a minimum depth of 150mm.

6 - 10mm aggregate laid from 40 - 100mm depth depending on location. Can include tree pit collar plus water irrigation system.

Compatible with channel watering systems.



